OBJECTIVES

There are three (3) residencies available:

2x supported residencies for emerging to mid-career contemporary dance and/or physical theatre artists where the successful applicant must meet both the criteria outlined below. This residency is supported by a bursary.

1x AUSTI. Company Artist where the successful applicant must be an AUSTI. Dance and Physical Theatre company artist for the residency period. This residency position is unpaid and is supported through choreographic mentorship.

ABOUT

The uNCOILEd exposed Residency offers two NSW-based artists the opportunity to work and collaborate with a group of committed and driven dancers. The first of its kind in the Illawarra, this innovative project invites proposals from AUSTI. company members and NSW-based emerging and mid-career choreographers, aged 18 years and over. As part of the residency, you will be provided with:

- 12 days studio access (10am 2pm)
- Access to AUSTI. company artists to be part of the development and perform in your work
- 3 show performance season at the Illawarra Performing Arts Centre
- Costumes for the performance
- Professional video and photo documentation of production
- Bursary of \$1000 (emerging to mid-career artist residencies only)

- Video evidence of past creative projects.
- Artistic innovation originality, creativity vocabulary, risk taking.
- Potential enhancement of skills and/or professionall practice of AUSTI. company artists.
- Capacity to develop new and diverse professional networks within AUSTI. community.
- Contribution to the development of the art form in the Illawarra.
- Artist application reflects one or more of the AUSTI. Values: Attitude / Unity / Support / Tenacity / Integrity.
- Preference given to artists currently residing in or with a strong connection to the Illawarra or AUSTI. Dance and Physical Theatre.
